The students have to solve the clues and find the correct picture cards. When they find the correct picture card, write the word on the Fall Word List.

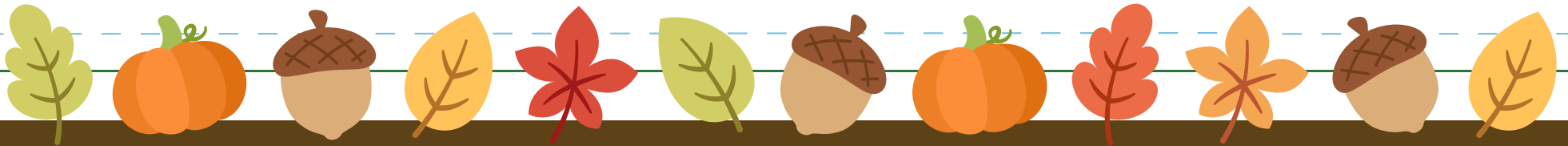





SMALL SCAVENGER HUNT CARDS

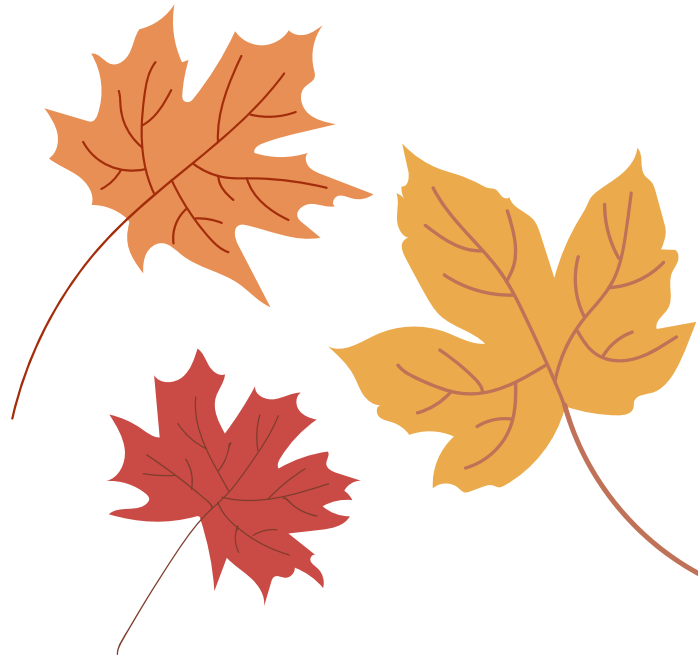




These come in different

Sweater



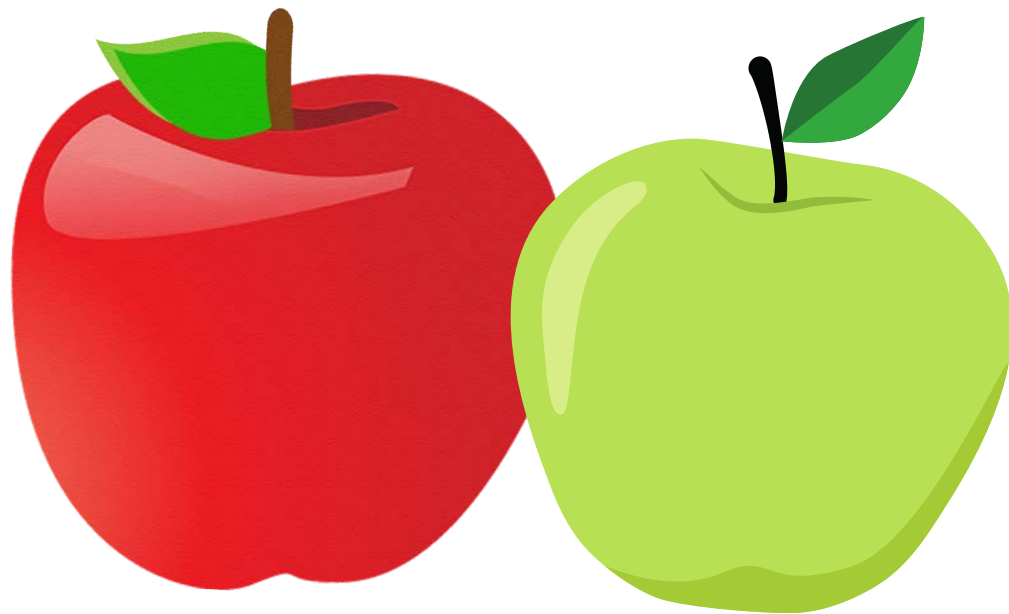


This is a red or green fruit

Apples

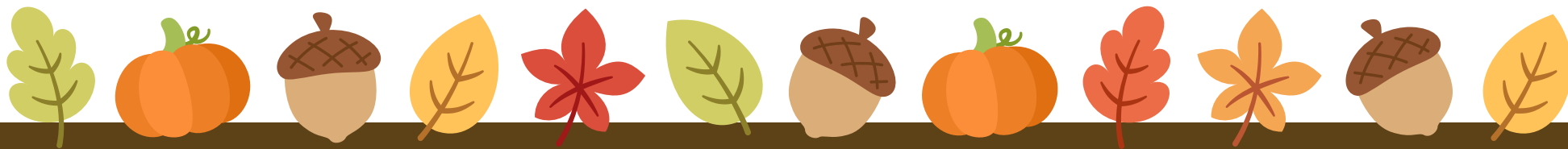
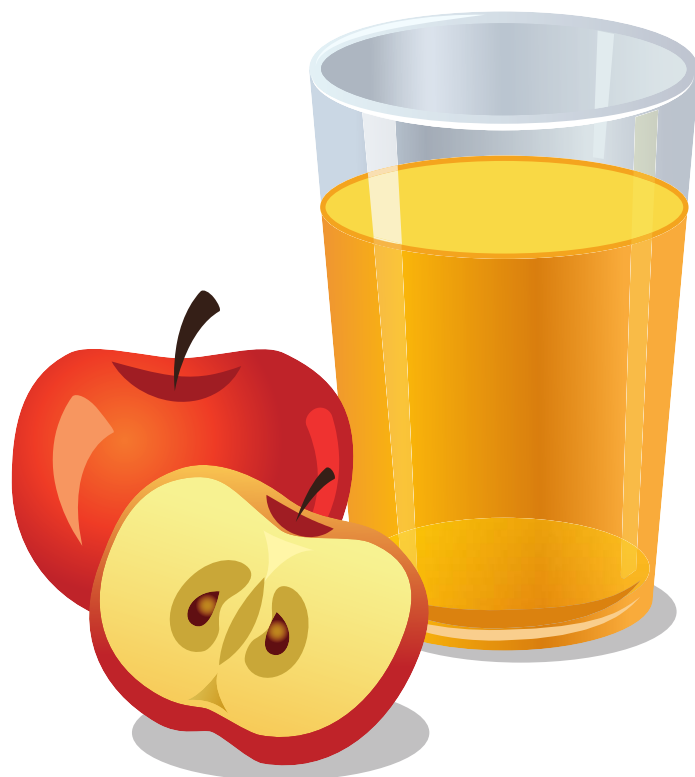


This is a drink made from fruit with seeds. It can be sweet and sometimes people drink it warm with spices.

Haystack

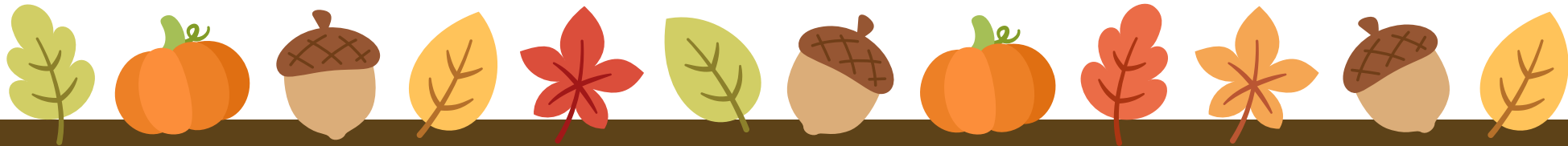
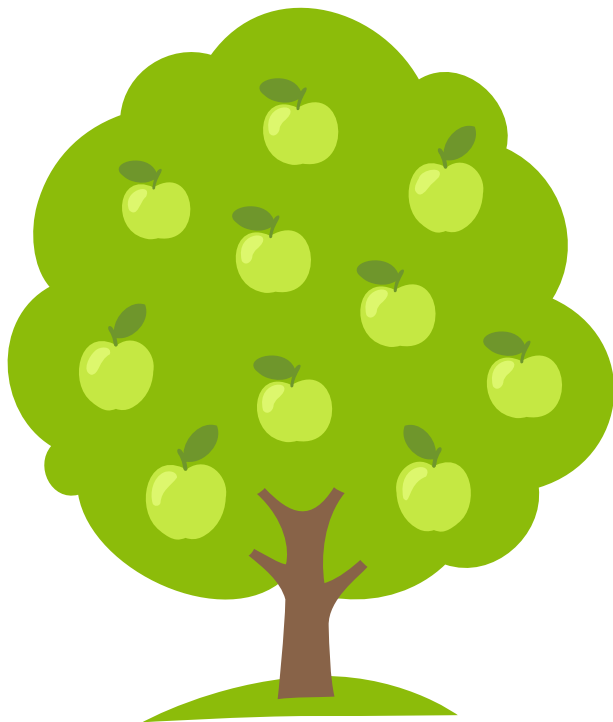
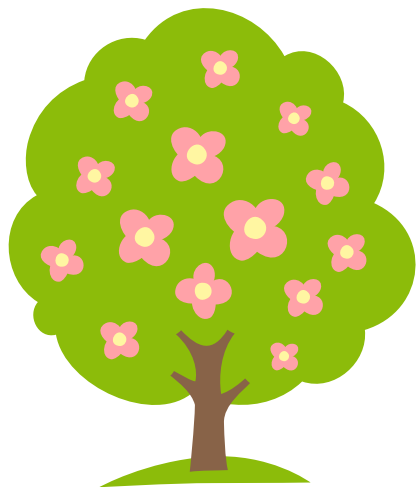


This is a place where
