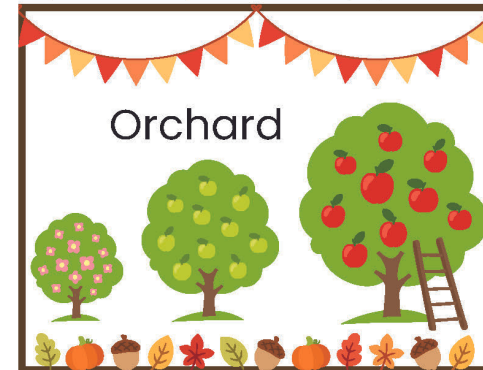
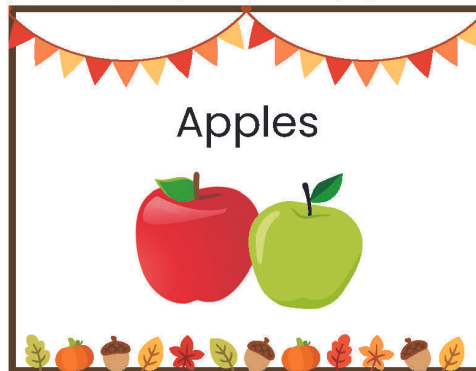
Directions:

The students have to solve the clues and find the correct picture cards. When they find the correct picture card, write the word on the Fall Word List.

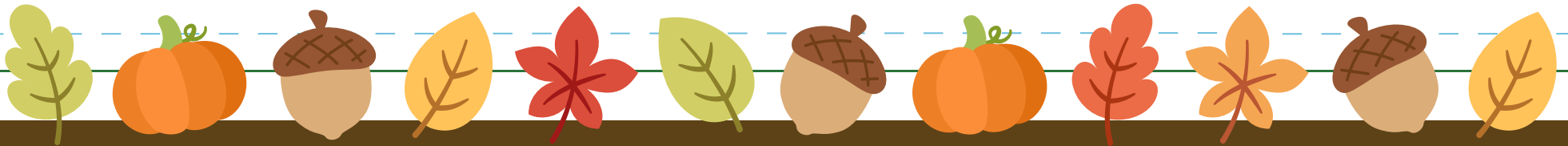




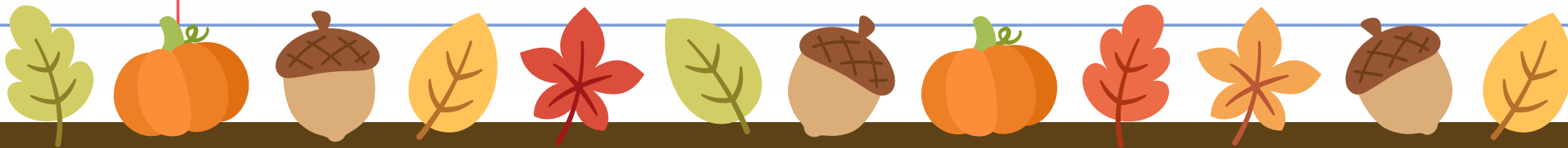

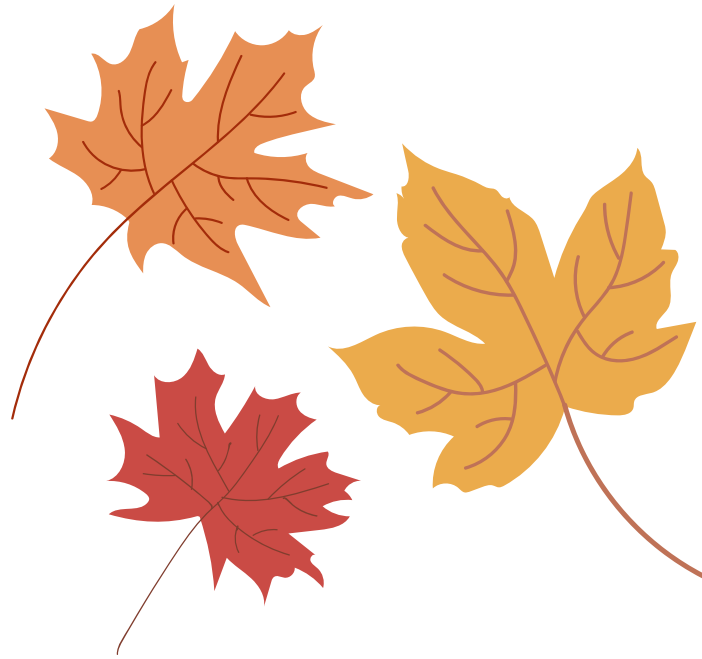


From trees they fall, in

Acorn



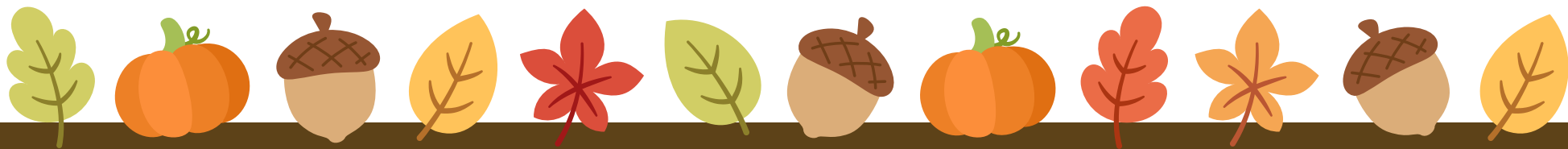


When chilly winds begin

Sweater

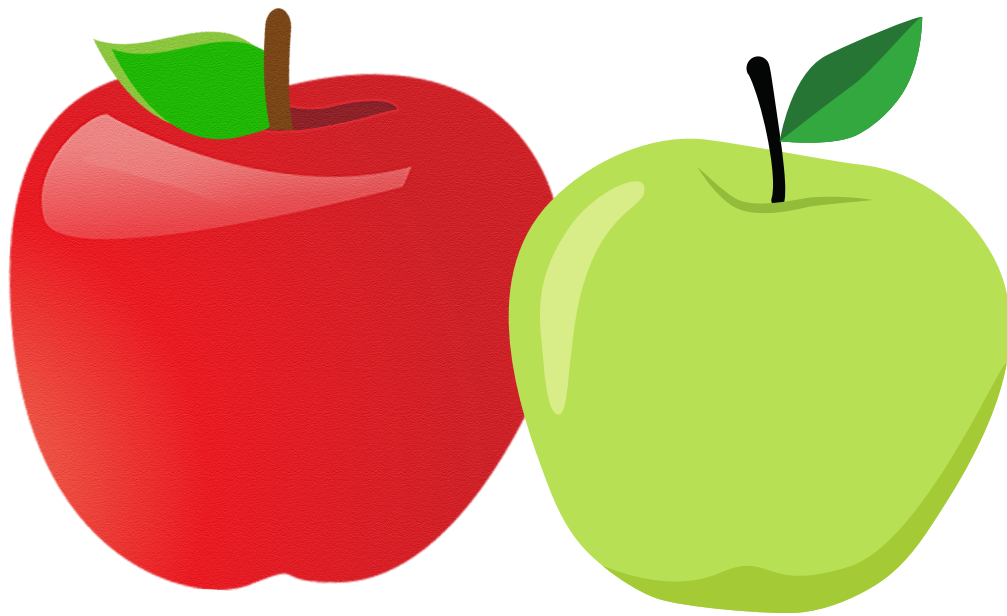


Red or green, on

Apples

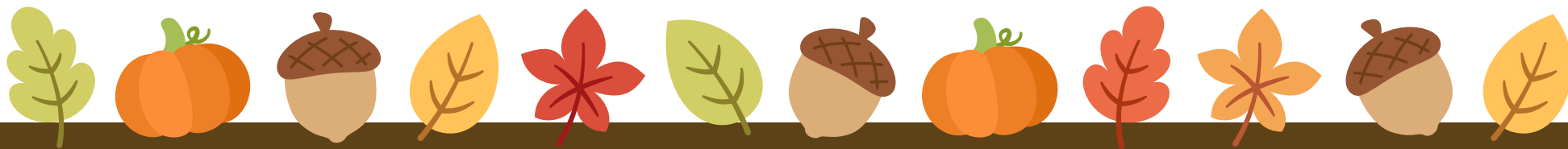
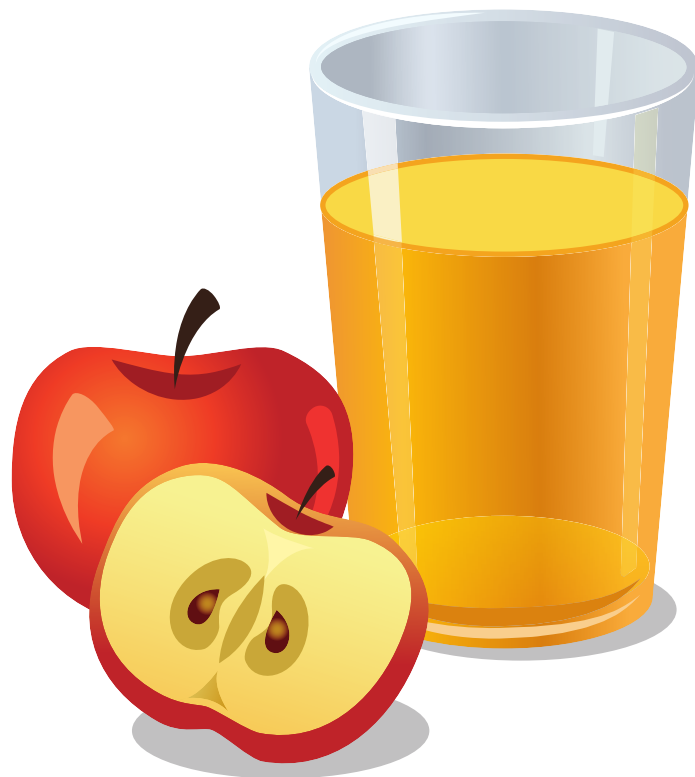



From fruits it's pressed, a

feet.





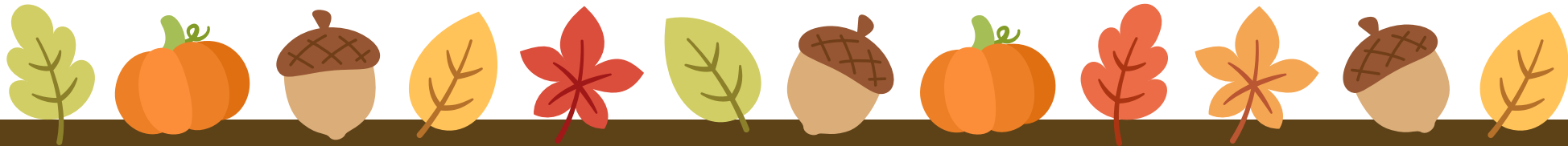
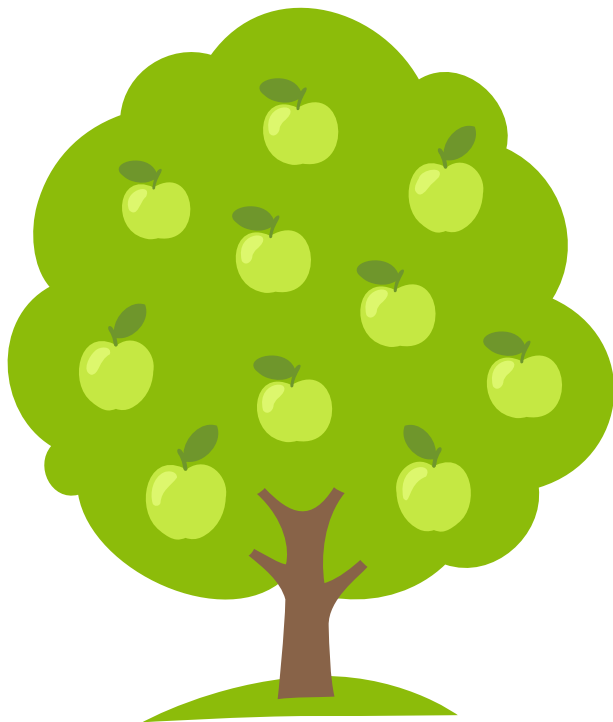
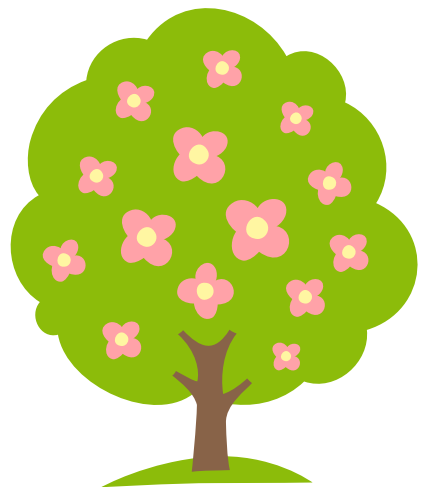
Haystack
